About the Survey

Graduates are defined as all Montcalm Community College students awarded a certificate or associates degree during the academic year 2016 based on Jenzabar enterprise resource planning records. In 2016 academic year 424 degrees were awarded to 350 students.

In cases where students received more than one award, the student's responses were recorded under each major code but not included in the general statistic. NR means no response. Survey results are also available by major code.

Surveys were e-mailed to graduates within six months of their degree being conferred, with the exception of Medical Assistant program students who received a survey four months afterward (per program requirements). Two electronic reminders were sent to students who didn't respond within a week. A post office mailing was sent to students who didn't respond within two weeks. Surveys closed within a month of the open date.

Employment Results

Employment Status

The percentage of respondents that said:

- I am employed- 92.04%, (104 out of 113) of graduates are employed. Students who are unemployed, but not looking for employment are excluded from this count (13). This represents an increase of 4% in the employment rate from the previous year.
- 47.57%, (49 out of 103) of graduates who are employed, indicated that their job is very related or somewhat related to their field of study. The main reasons why jobs were not in related field were listed as: "I am continuing my education" 66% and "I'm not sufficiently qualified for a job in my field" 15%.
- 7%, (9 out of 126) of graduates indicated that they are unemployed and seeking employment.
- 10%, (13 out of 126) of respondents indicated that they are unemployed but not seeking employment.
