- Elective courses: two upper-level non-required courses that total a minimum of 4 credits. See RN-to-BSN Coordinator at SVSU to help identify possible options.
- If you are planning to go straight into SVSU's MSN program, some of these courses may not be required. Please check with the RN-to-BSN Coordinator at SVSU prior to taking these classes.
