Prerequisite classes offered at Montcalm Community College (MCC) to be completed prior to admission into the PTA Program are as follows:

BIOL 202 and	4	Human Anatomy & Physiology I

ENGL 100	3	Freshman English 1
COMM 210	3	Speech

Note: BIOL 100 General Biology is also recommended.

BIOL 202 and BIOL 203 both need to be taken at MCC to transfer to MMCC as BIO 141 and BIO 142.

PTA 101, which is a prerequisite (Orientation to Physical Therapy, 1 credit) is to be taken at MMCC or equivalent earned.

The following General Education courses included in the shared PTA curriculum are offered at MCC. It is recommended that they be completed prior to beginning the program.

CMIS 101	3	Computer Literacy

CMIS 115	3	Intro to Computer Info Systems
MATH 100	3	Elementary Algebra
PSYC 120	3	General Psychology
POLI 240	3	The American Political Systems

Additionally, HUM 200 or HUM 253 is to be taken at MMCC or equivalent earned. This requirement may also be met by taking 9 hrs of Humanities with at least 3 credits at the 200 level, or 6 hrs of Humanities & 3 hrs of Fine Arts, one of which is at the 200 level.

PHY 101 (Introductory Physics, 3 credits) is to be taken at MMCC or equivalent earned.

For all prerequisite courses, a grade of a "B-" or higher must be earned unless an institution uses a non-standard scale. Then, a grade of a BC (2.5) must be earned.

Anatomy & Physiology courses must have been completed within five years of the date the student formally begins the program.

Students who have earned a bachelor's degree will be exempt from both the 100 and 200 level general education requirements with the exception of math.
