Virgil Wander, by bestselling author Leif Enger, is a sweeping story of new beginnings against all odds that follows the inhabitants of a hard luck town in their quest to revive its flagging heart. Carried aloft by quotidian pleasures of kite-flying, movies, fishing, baseball, necking in parked cars and falling in love, Virgil Wander is a swift, full journey into the heart and heartache of an often-overlooked upper Midwest.

Since we were unable to gather for a kick-off event, books will be available for purchase at the Montcalm Community College Bookstore, operated by Barnes & Noble, on the college's Sidney campus, when the campus reopens to the public, and will continue to be available at the bookstore throughout the course of the One Book + MCC Reads program. At this time, the college is not announcing a reopening date due to the often-changing nature of the guidelines for public gathering due to COVID-19.
