General Description: Montcalm Community College is seeking candidates to teach part-time as an Introduction to Anatomy & Physiology Biology Instructor and/or Lab Instructor. Please be sure to specify on your application what your course teaching interest is and the time availability to teach.

Introduction to Anatomy & Physiology - The overall objective of BIOL105 is to introduce the principles and processes of biology through the study of the human organism. Students gain an understanding of how the human body functions through a detailed study of each organ system that comprises the human body. This course gives students a perspective of how the human body maintains homeostasis through the interaction of organ system functions. Current topics in health sciences, nutrition, biology and medicine are discussed as they pertain to specific organ systems. Laboratory exercises include dissection and physiological experiments pertinent to the topics covered. Students have an option to observe and use a human cadaver.

Lab Instructors would receive pay for 2 contact hours (teaching only lab portion of the course)

Biology Instructors would receive pay for 5 contact hours (teaching both lecture & lab)

Qualifications:

- Lab Instructor Bachelor's degree in Biology or Education (with science background) from a regionally accredited university (master's degree preferred)
- Biology Instructor Master's degree from a regionally accredited university with a minimum of 18 graduate credit hours in the discipline
- Previous teaching experience preferred but not required
- Commitment to community college philosophy
- Understanding of and experience with technology as a learning tool, both within and outside the classroom
