2024 Mill Levy Renewal Proposal



Just the Facts

- ✓ Montcalm Community College is considering asking voters to renew a mill levy in 2024.
- ✓ The size of the mill levy is approximately 1.15 mills.
- ✓ The college is not seeking to increase the size of the current mill levy.
- ✓ The mill levy funds approximately 19% of the college's total budget to support:
 - More than 50 associate, certificate, and job-training programs
 - Keeping tuition and fees affordable
 - Workforce training and apprenticeship programs
 - Recruitment and retention of quality faculty and staff
 - Replacement of outdated instructional tools and technology
 - Day-to-day operations and maintenance needs
 - Student services
- ✓ The mill levy benefits more than 3,300 students each year, including high schoolers participating in the college's dual-enrollment program.
- ✓ The decision to pursue the mill levy renewal in 2024 will be made later this fall after the college gathers additional public input. Nothing is set in stone at this time.
